In English, the letter q is usually followed by the letter u. Although this is true in the vast majority of cases, there are some exceptions, whose most prominent are Arabic, Chinese, Hebrew, Inuktitut or other languages that do not use the English alphabet, with q representing a sound not found in English. For example, in the Chinese Pinyin alphabet, q is pronounced /tʃʰ/, as Pinyin uses q to represent the sound [tʃʰ], which is approximate as [tʃ] in English. In other examples, q represents [q] (in standard ARBR, as in QAT, FAOIR and QU'An, and alternative grafias are sometimes accepted that use k in place of Q). Almost all these words are nouns, and most would generally be considered as such. However, they are all considered naturalized in English according to at least one great dictionary (see referrals), often because they refer to concepts or societal papers that do not have a precise equivalent in English. So that words appear here, they should appear in their own entry into a dictionary; Words that occur only as part of a longer phrase are not included. In addition, there are many names of personal places and names, mainly originating from Northern Africa, in the East or China, who have one q without you. The most familiar of these are the Iraq and Qatar countries along with the words Iraqi and Qatari derived. Iqaluit, the capital of the Canadian territory of Nunavut, also has a Q, which is not followed directly by a U. Qaqortoq and qeqertarsuq, both in Groenlândia, are not noticeable to the eye for having three qs naked. Other suitable names and acronym that have reached the status of English words include: Compaq (Company of Informatics), Qantas (A Australian Aerial Company), Nasdaq (US Electric Ações Market) and Qinetiq (a British technology company). ZAQQM (a tree mentioned in the Quran) and Saqqara are suitable substantive nouns to the eye.

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
