Ivor is an antagonist transformed one of the deuteragonists in Minecraft: Story Mode. He is a former disgraced member of the Order of the Stone. He's voiced by Paul Reubens. He first appeared in "The Order of the Stone". Overview Appearance Ivor has slow black hair - which, starting from the second season, was tied in a topknot, a long beard and wears a green olive coat and trousers. Wear also a belt with a lapis lazuli gem. In one of the flashbacks, it has proved to have an armor with a shade of olive and blue. He was wearing fingerless gloves and gold boots. He also wears a white canoe with blue and white striped boxer under his "adventurous clothing" as shown in episode 8. Ivor's personality at first seems to be grumbling, impatient, cynical and arrogant. In previous episodes, Ivor was shown to be a hostile man with a grudge against Gabriel and the Order of Stone, and since he created the Storm of Wither, he was thought to be the antagonist. While history progressed, however, the truth about the Order of the Stone was discovered and the true motivations of Ivor were revealed. He ransomed by helping Jesse defeat the storm of Wither by giving Jesse the enchanted book. He also finds Jesse's group and warns them about the Tempeste Wither following the Amulet. He also shows remorse when he discovers that Jesse had Gabriel's Amulet and therefore, the Tempeste Wither were following them. Ivor has since become a supporting character who accompanies the New Order of Stone in their adventures, now he is in good relations with them. It proves much more exciting, but it is still very eccentric and thinks it's bigger than the lower community, as shown when he says to Jesse, "I won't be threatened - not by those like you." But he is still deeply concerned about his friends, but above all he denies it. He is also directly responsible for saving Jesse's life in Sky City, pushing them out of the street of the firebals of some Ghost. He also grabbed Jesse's hand when the two fell from a waterfall (if the player doesn't grab the screws in time.) Jesse Reports "Ivor is fantastic." —Jesse a Petra on Ivor. (Determinator) src At first, Ivor and Jesse were enemies. However, when Jesse discovers that Ivor is not a bad boy, their relationship becomes much more stable and become good friends. Jesse also thinks Ivor sometimes makes them laugh. Ivor also shows compassion for Jesse by helping them in trouble, even saving their lives at some point. He also shows a lot of care for Jesse through his return when he heard about Jesse can not be found on the surface and do not realize that the admin was the fake Jesse, but "helped" him forthe "imposter" that was the real Jesse. Petra "Yes, although it can be impulsive and fly out of the handle, Petra's Petra'sthe instinct is very sharp." —Ivoring about Petra. (Determinator) src Petra and Ivor do not have a good relationship between them because of him that scam on their deal giving them a lapis instead of a diamond. Starting in episode 5, Petra is the only person who still has anger against Ivor. During the episode, Petra is constantly angry with him and did not appreciate the idea of Ivor being arrested to enter the palace, so she did not go with him. In episode 6, Petra enjoyed Ivor's volunteering to watch over Lukas. He also said "Nope, don't happen" when Ivor thought he would be killed next to the white pumpkin, showing that Petra was deeply concerned about Ivor. Lukas "But don't go get funny ideas, blond boy! This is not because I like you or anything." —She comes to Lukas, when she decides to look at Lukas.) At first, Lukas and Ivor were not shown to interact, but because of Ivor scam Petra for an agreement, Lukas allegedly held grudge against him. However, when the truth about the true motives of the Order and Ivor was revealed, Lukas' opinion on him changes. Since then, it has proved to have a fundamental but positive relationship. Ivor volunteers also to help Lukas in episode 6, showing that he also cares about him, although Ivor denies that he does. When Ivor appears without his "adventurous clothes", Lukas finds his funny look and says he can't take it seriously in this way, to which Ivor responds by saying that his dress breathes wonderfully. The old order of the Ivor stone was the fifth member of the old order before it dissolved. In "Above and Beyond", he says he wants to "quadragnate the rift" with them, after everything he did. Harper "You're unbelievable..." —Respond after Harper returns to Crown Mesa/leaves the band.) Ivor has shown to respect Harper. Empathy with her, perhaps because both have a similar story with both their creations that go out of hand. He also calls it "intriguing person." In Episode 8, Ivor may have developed an interest in Harper, as he held the rose from his lab. In Hero in Residence, it is confirmed that they now live happily together with Beacontown and also go on adventures together. (Determinant) src Trivia Ivor is the first person to create a great antagonist, the storm Wither, in the series. The second is Harper, with the PAMA. In episode 1, when Ivor arrives through the Nether Portal, Jesse has a chance to punch him. Later, Jesse can apologize for hitting him when his real motives are discovered. Jesse can also try to punch him in The Underneath, but Ivor, with his new ninja skills, dodge. Unlike the rest of the Order of Stone, Ivor's ability is never mentioned. However, it is shown to be an alchemist/incantism/mage due to its frequent use of potions and spells. Ivor breaks the fourth wall in "A Portal to Mystery" by winning the player and saying "Adventure!" He still does so in the end of "Access Denied", except that he ends with a question mark. This seems to be a gag, like at the end of "A Journey's End?"., runs away with the enchanted Flint and Steel and the Atlas and says it again, off-screen. In the miniature of the Adventure Pass, Ivor seems to have a second appearance with his armor, except without a helmet on. In episode 7, after Jesse kills an unskilled zombie, Ivor's sword seems to be a stone sword on one side and one of gold on the other. Based on some of his comments and his maintenance of a rose from Episode 8, Ivor may have a romantic interest in Harper. But this could have been purely platonic, and only a compliment to Harper. Ivor is seen without his "Adventuring Clothes" in "A Journey's End?". It seems to wear a white canopy and striped blue shorts, much for Jesse (determinant) and Lukas' fun. Ivor is the only member of the Old Order who appeared in all episodes of Season 1. Ivor is also the only member to make a full appearance in Season 2. Other members are mentioned, but not seen in person. Ivor says the same thing the Narrator says at the beginning of episode 1: "No building canforever." This is told to Gabriel when Ivor is about to create the Wither storm. In Adventure Pass's advertising art, Ivor has his armor from episode 1, but never has it in Episode 6,7, neitherHe's got everything except his helmet. Ivor was a member of the Order of the Stone who left / went out due to the other lies of the group on the Dragon Ender. One of Ivor's favorite things is lava, as shown in his lava house and his "heart" lava in Sky City. Ivor is the only character to be in the Old Order of Stone and the New Order of Stone. Ivor is the only member of the Old Stone Order to appear in Season 2. If you notice, Ivor's sword in "Below the Bedrock" is longer than a normal diamond sword, similar to that of Emily.
