It produces a high contrast effect while preserving harmony. This composition seems lively even when using pale and unsaturated colors. This is a combination of 2 to 5 (ideally 2 to 3) colors that are adjacent to each other on the color circle. Create a calm and pleasant impression. It is a scheme that includes a primary and two complementary colors, plus an additional color that highlights accents. An example: blue-green, blue-violet, orange red, orange yellow. A combination of 4 colors that are equidistant to each other on the color circle. In this case, colors differ from each other in tone, but are also complementary. This creates a dynamic, vivid and playful effect. One example: purple, orange red, yellow, blue-green. White: it combines with everything, especially blue, red and black. Beige: it combines with blue, brown, emerald, black, red, white. Grey: it combines with fuchsia, red, purple, pink, blue.
