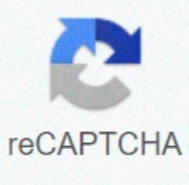

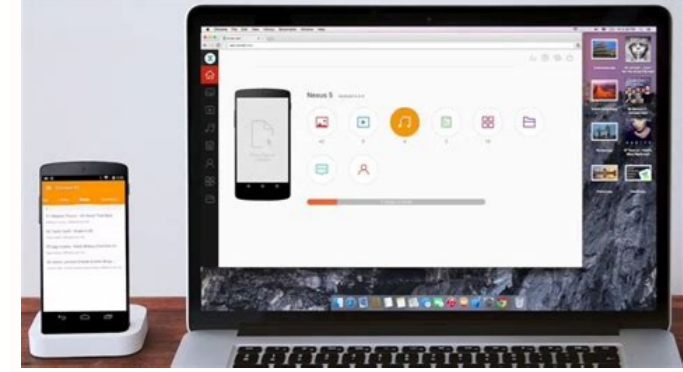

1 Download and install AirDroid on your Android device. AirDroid is a popular app that you can use to transfer Android files to PC among other things. It can be downloaded for free. Some features require a paid subscription, but you can use the file transfer functionality for free. To download and install AirDroid on your Android device, follow these steps: Open the Google Play Store. Type "AirDroid" in the search bar at the top. Press AirDroid in the search results. Click Install. 2 Download and install the Ardroid Companion app for your PC. Ardroid Companion app is available for Windows PC and Mac. Follow the steps below to download and install the Ardroid companion app. 3 Open Ardroid on your android device. AirDroid has a green icon that looks like a white paper plane. Tap the icon on the home screen or in the application menu to open AirDroid. You can also click "Open" on the Google Play Store after the download and installation is complete. 4 Save or connect to a new account. If you already have an Ardroid account, press Connect at the bottom of the screen and enter the email address and password associated with your account. If you don't have an account, click register below. Enter your e-mail address, password and pseudonym. Then click "Register" at the bottom. You will then need to receive a confirmation code in your email, enter it and click Confirm. When you first open AirDroid, you will be prompted to allow access to your Android storage. Click Continue, then authorize to authorize access to phone storage. 5 Check the features you want to use, then press . If you want to use any of the other features in the Remote Security and Features menu, do so now. Include files to send files. To activate other functions, press the function you want to use and press authorization. Then click "Authorize" to allow the application to use these features.



Then click the back arrow in the upper left corner to return to the main menu. 6 Connect to the Android Companion application on your computer. The application has the same green icon with a white paper plane. Open the Android Companion application on your computer. Then enter the email address and password associated with your account and click "Connection" on the right.

7 Press Send. This is the first option at the bottom of the Ardroid application screen on your Android device. Tap this icon to see a list of devices you can create. 8 Enter the computer. If your computer is free, it should do it "Remote Connection Mode". Click on the computer to connect. A chat window for your computer will open. 9 Click the paperclip or picture icon. This option is located next to the text field at the bottom of the screen. When you want to send a file, tap the paperclip icon. To send a picture, touch the picture icon. 10 Select the type of file you want to send (if you are sending a file).

Use the options in the pop-up window to select the type of file you want to send. The following options are available: Application: Send the application to the computer. Camera: Take a photo with the camera and send it to your computer.



Video: Send video files to your computer. Music: Send audio files to your computer. Files: Send any type of file stored in Android's internal storage to your computer. File (SD card): Sends all file types stored on the SD card to the computer. 11 Check the box next to the files you want to send. The tag is in the upper right corner of the image or video thumbnail preview or to the right of the file name. You can select as many files as you want. 12 Click Submit. This option is in the lower right corner. This will send the files to your computer. 13 In the companion application, accept the files by clicking the magnifying glass icon. The magnifying glass icon is in the lower right corner of the preview thumbnail or to the right of the file name.



The folder where the files are stored will open.

By default, all files sent via AirDroid are saved to the "PublicStaging" folder in AirDroid's "Documents" folder. If you need to send photos from your phone to your computer, you can use email, Google Photos, or even a direct cable connection. However, you may find it faster and more convenient to transfer them wirelessly from your phone to your computer.

Microsoft once offered an app called Photos Companion that would allow iPhone and Android users to transfer photos to Windows 10 PCs, but it has been discontinued. Instead, Android users can use the Microsoft Your Phone app, while iPhone users will have to find third-party options that can handle the job. Your phone number. To get started with your phone, first go to Settings > Phone and the Phone button in Windows 10.



The Your Phone desktop app will open and ask you to choose your phone type. Select Android and click Next. Your phone will ask you to verify your Microsoft account.

Click Continue. Install yoursGeneral Program (opened in new window) Android. Open the app and connect your phone to your computer, connect with your Microsoft account or with a QR code. Code scanning is faster so click your computer has a QR code?

Link and click next to the next screen. Back on your phone's desktop, check yes, I'm done installing your phone. Click the "Open QR" button. The QR code appears in the table. Use your smartphone's camera to scan the QR code. In the Mobile app, click the button to continue and then grant the necessary permissions to access your contacts, phone calls, media, and messages. Click the "Continue" button. Select the background app currently. You can always change it later. Click authorization to allow the phone and connect the phone to the Windows computer. Click Complex on the next screen. This screen confirms that your phone and computer are connected. Press the button on the computer, let's go. You should then see an app linked to your phone.



Tap Settings > Simply put and activate the toggle to allow this app to view my phone photos if it's not already done. The main program should be automatically displayed on your last 25 screen and screen images.

If this is not the case, click on the photo input, select the Show Photo button. Click on any photo to open. For more options, you will find a suitable image and open the context menu to copy, share or store the photo on your computer.

You can also select many photos that once download or delete.photosync photosync (iOS (opens in a new window), Android (opens in a new window) also uses mobile and stationary applications. You can send photos to your computer with Windows or Mac , a network memory device or a mass storage site such as OneDrive or Dropbox. The basic application is free but limits your photos with low quality JPG images. With a purchase or subscription of \$ 13.99 for 99 cents per month or \$ 2.99, you get conversions of superior quality images and other additional features per year. Decorate the application on the phone and then install a free photosync companion application (open the free application of free in one new window) in Windows or Mac.

Perform the mobile application that will automatically display the camera. Choose the photos you want to move, or transfer all the photos from your library or simply selected images. Save the destination as a computer, another phone, tablet or storage site. If you choose a computer, make sure that the connected application is running on Windows or Mac. Tap the name of your computer in your mobile application.
